- Develop and implement safety systems, policies and procedures in compliance with all governmental regulation including local, state and federal OSHA rules and current ISO standards as they apply to wind turbine construction activities
- Advise management on actions needed to comply and enforce all safety systems
- Develop all safety policies in coordination with the Division Operations Manager and Wind Division Manager. Policies will be designed to provide employee safety and health by reducing work-related injuries and illnesses
- Oversee management and coordination of Environmental Health & Safety (EHS) on construction sites, includes evaluation of EHS performance of Subcontractors
- Responsible for conducting site visits, inspections and audits designed to identify and prevent unsafe working conditions at field locations
- Oversee the coordination of accident investigations in partnership with Site Managers to determine appropriate corrective and/or preventative safety measures where indicated
- Responsible for the development, documentation and delivery of corrective action recommendations for review by operational management
- Provide monthly reporting to management of safety performance metrics, delinquencies in training activity and relevant Worker's Compensation activity
- Develop, implement and manage safety training programs for all Wind Division employees.
- Monitor training activities to ensure proper completion of required training programs
- Coordinate the administration of the Wind Division workers compensation claims with the HR department; quarterly claims, managing the recordkeeping of recordable occupational injuries and coordination workers compensation review with the insurance company's case managers
- Position requires occasional travel to project sites to monitor/audit safety programs
- Full-time position, salary, benefits package, incentive pay
